Phius Certified Builder (CPHB) training offers real-world insights into the on-site implementation of building designs. This training will cover strategies for both the practical application of passive building principles and the business concerns specific to high-performance and zero-energy building. This course also covers more than just craftsmanship – other topics include the risks and liabilities Phius Certified Builders face, along with guidance for both solving and avoiding problems.

Phius Certified Builder Training consists of two parts plus an exam:

- **Part I:** Approximately 8 hours of self-paced study in advance of live online classes
- **Part II:** Live instruction totaling 24 hours, split into eight 3-hour online sessions over two weeks
- **Exam:** The Phius Certified Builder certification exam is offered following the course
- Students who pass the exam earn CPHB credential
